The short submission allows for longitudinal designs (including the replication of items already fielded in the GESIS Panel in the past) but not for data collection with experimental designs. If you plan to conduct an experiment, please use our regular submission procedure. The questionnaire must not exceed a survey duration of one minute per survey wave (according to **our** time measurement). Each of the following bullet points correspond to **approximately** one minute:



- Five short single-choice questions
- Three multiple-choice questions with a maximum of seven items
- Two open-ended questions

The following General Terms and Conditions apply:

#### Non-commercial usage

- The GESIS Panel does not accept any commercial data collection projects.
- Data collected within the GESIS Panel may be used for (non-commercial) scientific purposes only. Any partially or fully commercial usage is prohibited.

#### **Data protection**

- GESIS Leibniz Institute for the Social Sciences and all commissioned service providers work according to the regulations of the EU General Data Protection Regulation. Further, all statutory data protection provisions of the Federal Republic of Germany apply.
- Any attempt to de-anonymize data that is, to try to identify individual respondents is a criminal offense.
- The submitters are responsible for reviewing the questionnaire by an ethics committee. Further information on this can be found in our FAQ.

### Royalty-free, non-exclusive material

- All measurement instruments used within the GESIS Panel will be accessible to the
  academic social science community. Therefore, primary researchers must ensure
  that the data collection instruments they submit to the GESIS Panel do not violate

- The GESIS Panel Team reserves the exclusive right to accept or reject proposals.



#### Charges

- The fielding of accepted studies is free of charge.

- As GESIS Panel surveys are fielded in German, English-language instruments must be translated into German before we start with preparing the respective survey wave. Translation costs must be borne by those submitting the study proposal.
